Important information about your enrolment

You have been conditionally or fully admitted to a Master's programme of the Graduate School of Humanities (GSH) at the University of Amsterdam. In this email we will explain how to proceed with your enrolment.

Send in your certified documents

If you have not already done so, you will need to send us official transcripts and diploma(s) or a graduation statement by post for verification purposes. **These documents must be certified.** Please send them to us as soon as possible, and before 1 August. The earlier we receive the documents, the earlier you can finalise your enrolment.

Start looking for accommodation

As with many major European cities, the demand for housing in Amsterdam is very high. We advise that you start looking for accommodation in Amsterdam well in advance of your arrival. The University of Amsterdam offers a number of **housing options** for international students, who start studying in Amsterdam for the first time. If you are eligible for UvA accommodation you will receive an email invitation to apply for UvA housing by the end of May. The early Bird deadline is 7 June. We recommend all students to apply before this date. You can also look for

Visit our introduction days

The academic year starts on 4 September. The University of Amsterdam and the Faculty of Humanities organize a number of events and meetings to help you acclimatise in Amsterdam. We therefore recommend that you arrive a few weeks before the start of the semester, preferably by 18 or 21 August. These are the dates of the **Pick-up service** for international students and the all-inclusive start appointment. On 28 August, the Faculty of Humanities will organise the Faculty introductory meeting. The programme introductions will also take place during the week from 28 August to 1 September.

Check your study programme

To get an impression of the courses offered within the Master's programme for which you have been accepted, check **your programme**.

Upload your English test (if required)

You will be able to see whether you are required to upload an English test on your **Personal Service Page**. If you still need to do so, please upload your English language test results as soon as possible.

Choose your programme

If you have been accepted for more than one of our programmes, please let us know as soon as possible by email (AdmissionsMA-fgw@uva.nl) which offer you intend to accept. Your choice may have consequences for the **tuition fees** you will be required to pay.

Finalise your enrolment

You will be receiving emails from the Admissions and International Office of the Graduate School of Humanities and from the Central UvA Administration. It is important that you read

these messages carefully as they contain important information regarding the status of your application and enrolment.

All non-Dutch students will need to fill out an immigration form at myinfo.uva.nl. Please do so as soon as you receive an email regarding this subject. If you require a visa or residence permit, you will need to apply in time.

Please be sure to check your junk mail folder regularly and add all email addresses ending with uva.nl.

We look forward to welcoming you at the start of the new academic year.
